**Attention! The requirement for operation is
a DISPLAY (VGA) and MFII Keyboard (if possible MOUSE).**

Install description ICU-KIT

**The ICU-KIT is for mixed hardware configurations (non Plug&Play/Plug&Play).
This tool is useful to bypass the ISA / PCI conflicts (Interrupts,
Ports, DMA and Memory).**

**If you want to work with the ICU-KIT you need one formatted floppy and aprox
3,3MB free space on harddisk C:.
The free space is for creating a new directory (plugplay.sni) which contains
the ICU work base.**

The following steps are very important.

- 1. Copy ICU_KIT.EXE to the floppy**
- 2. Change to floppy (a:) and Start ICU_KIT (self extracting file)**
- 3. Call (a:)install from DOS-Prompt or DOS-Windows (NOT from a
Windows file manager like Explorer)**

The additional information follows during the further installation.

COMMENT:

**If you have created a bootable ICU floppy it's possible to work on
further systems. That means, you boot your system from drive (C:)
and start at point 3. ((a:)install).**
