### State-of-the-art cash recycling technology

While not new to cash recycling technology, Banca Raiffeisen Locarno has taken its recycling capabilities to the next level with the recent installation of the DN Series 250V. The dual recycling cassettes provide maximum flexibility for depositing and withdrawing Swiss francs and euros. For the bank, which covers an area close to the Italian border, this is a key advantage: "Our customers appreciate denomination choice at the ATM, and thanks to DN Series recycling technology, we can give them just that," explains Massimo Nava, private client advisor at Banca Raiffeisen Locarno. The new DN Series systems support the recycling of up to eight different denominations, including euro notes. This technology also optimizes loading cycles, reducing cash handling costs.

### The right level of protection for every risk environment

Ensuring high-security standards and minimizing the risk of fraud are top priorities for any financial institution, and Banca Raiffeisen Locarno is no exception. In DN Series ATMs, security and privacy are at the heart of every design choice. Additional security measures can be implemented at any time based on the risk environment and the evolution of attack scenarios. Banca Raiffeisen Locarno has chosen to equip its ATMs with SBK7 intelligent inking systems, which neutralize banknotes as soon as tampering is detected. Their presence is advertised with highly visible stickers in an effort to prevent attacks.

### Solutions in line with the bank's sustainability policies

For Raiffeisen, sustainability means taking a responsible attitude as a business and being concerned about its ecological and social impact. By replacing a legacy Opteva device with a DN Series recycler, Raiffeisen Bank Locarno will save between 30 and 60% of energy and be able to thin out its cash replenishment cycles, further reducing its carbon emissions. At the bank's request, the decommissioned ATM was disposed of in an environmentally sound manner through Diebold Nixdorf's recycling program.
